CRITERION FOR SELECTION OF STUDENTS:

INSPIRE TALENT SCHOLARSHIP:

1. The beneficiaries of this scheme are the students who have secured the first three ranks for the previous academic year.

2. An amount of Rs 10,000/- is provided to the top three rank holders of each department.
3. The final selection/amount will be at the discretion of the Management.

PROMPTITUDE SCHOLARSHIP:

1. The beneficiaries of this scheme are the students who have an attendance record of 90% and above in the academic year.
2. A total sum of Rs 375000/- is distributed to the students who have an attendance record of 90% and above.
3. The final selection/amount will be at the discretion of the Management.

VIDYA VIKAS SCHOLARSHIP:

1. The beneficiaries of this scheme are the students who have secured more than 1000 marks in HSC/Equivalent examination.
2. Other factors for the selection of the students include economic status, family status, and educational background of the student as well as the literacy level of the parents, medical needs, disability, and other related factors that may impede the education of the student.
3. The final selection/ amount will be at the discretion of the Management.

K K GUPTA SCHOLARSHIP:

1. The beneficiaries of this scheme are the students who are the members of NSS committee in that academic year.
2. A total sum of Rs. 1,00,000 is distributed to the NSS volunteers.
3. The final selection/ amount will be at the discretion of the Management.
